Branch Park

Located near South Base off Lancaster Boulevard, features picnic as well as Branch Pond (pond is currently closed). Branch Memorial Park was dedicated May 24, 1968, in honor of Major General Irving Lewis "Twig" Branch, AFFTC Commander, who was killed when his T-38 crashed into Puget Sound Washington, January 1966. General Branch had served as commander of the AFFTC since July 29, 1961. Construction of this "Oasis in the desert" was made possible by the donations by Edwards AFB personnel, as well as contributions from individuals and businesses throughout the Antelope Valley. Branch Pond is maintained by ODR and when open is available for fishing to those with a base fishing license. Customers are responsible for acquiring a base fishing license. *Base fishing licenses will not be sold at this time due to low water levels.
