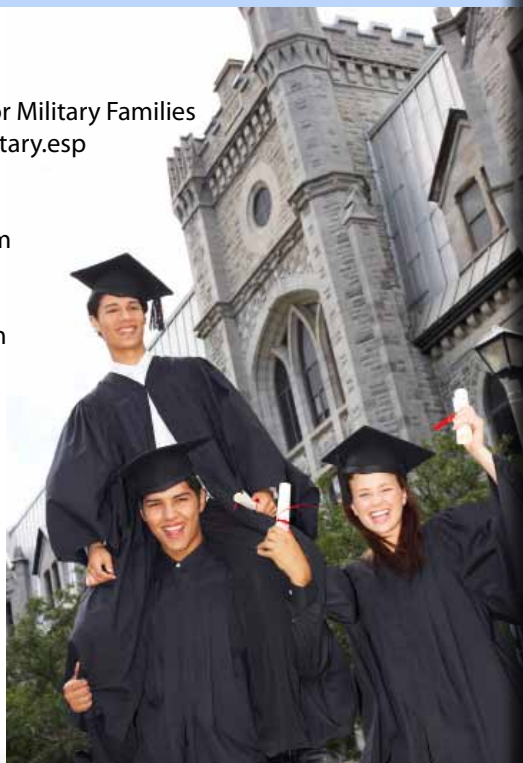

Edwards AFB SLO Information

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What is a School Liaison Officer (SLO)?

The School Liaison Officer (SLO) is the central point of contact for school related matters between the command, military families, and local school systems on issues which focus on partnership in education to include:

- Academics
- After School Programs
- Homeschooling
- School Transition
- IHE (Institutes of Higher Education)

In detail, the SLO's main goal is to ensure that our community is knowledgeable and aware of schooling options such as schools on Edwards AFB, schools in the surrounding areas, Home-schooling, Charter and Private Schools, along with policies and requirements when transferring into schools on Edwards AFB. Information can be obtained on courses offered, extra-curricular activities available through the schools and after school, non-competitive sports which are offered through our Family Members Programs. Also, find out information on state required testing in order to graduate, along with information on military and community resources.

When to Connect with your SLO

Once the sponsor receives orders to Edwards AFB, you have a choice of either contacting the SLO at your losing command or the SLO at the gaining command. He or she will be able to point you in the right direction for school needs for your dependent/s. This process should make your transition as stress free as possible. Just in case a SLO is not available, here is a checklist that will definitely assist:
